


Monastery NS Key Results of Parents' Survey March 2023


Do you feel that Monastery NS is well run and managed by the Board of Management, Principal and the In School Management Team?




1. Partnership with Parents




Which type of school communication do you feel is most effective? Please rank 1 to 4 with 1 being the best.




Do you feel that Monastery NS keeps you up to date regarding your child's education and wellbeing at school?



Do you use social media applications such as WhatsApp, Twitter, Instagram, Facebook, Tiktok etc? 73 responses




If you use Social Media please rank your favoured social media platform from 1 to 5 with one being the highest and five being the lowest?




Do you feel Monastery NS actively involves parents as partners in their child's education and wellbeing?




Have you ever been involved in any school activity?




Have you ever attended a training course or information night for parents? E.g. Cookery course, Incredible Years programme, Internet Safety, Yoga classes etc. 73 responses




2. Literacy

My child is a confident speaker and can tell people what they need. 73 responses




My child can confidently tell what their reading preferences are.




My child is a good listener.




My child likes reading.




I often listen to my child reading aloud.




My child often reads books, other than their school reading book at home.




My child has lots of books at home to read.




My child is a member of the local library.




My child writes for fun at home.




My child enjoys working with numbers.




My child likes to figure out how things work and enjoys solving problems.




I know my child's strengths in Maths.




I know my child's weaknesses in Maths.




The maths my child learns is at just the right level of difficulty.








The school is welcoming and accessible to parents / guardians.




The school has great modern facilities, is well maintained, attractive and bright. 73 responses





My child is safe and well looked after in the school.






The school is committed to dealing with any parental concerns or problems your child may have during their time in our school.




My child reports that school staff interact with him/her in a calm and respectful manner, even when there are disagreements.




The school sees health and wellbeing as important.








Do you feel that new pupils settle easily into our school? 73 responses




